Traffic collision occurs when a vehicle collides with a vehicle, animal, a tree or a pole. Traffic collisions may result in injury, death and property damage. A number of factors contribute to the risk of collisions, including speed design, speed of operation, road design and driver skill. Even skillful drivers are likely to make such collisions especially when they are under the effect of drugs or alcohol or when they are speeding or racing. These accidents, of course, cause physical, financial and sometimes social problems for both individuals and the society. But what could be done to prevent, or, at least, restrict these collisions.
